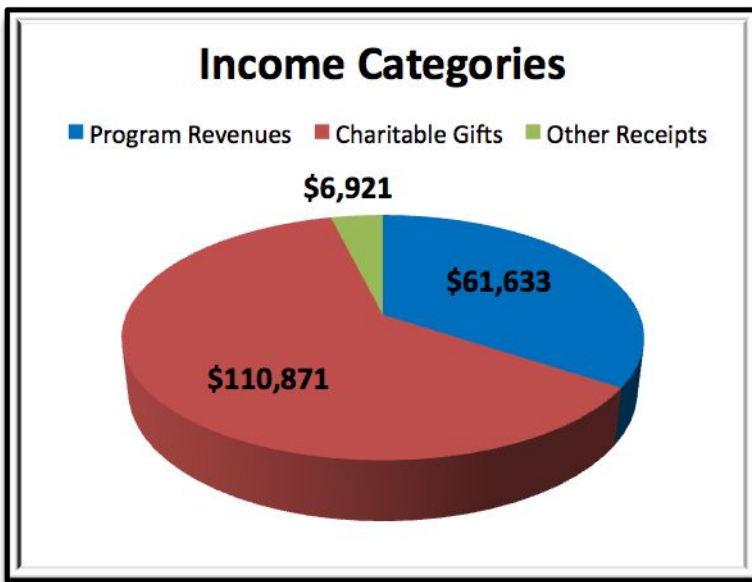
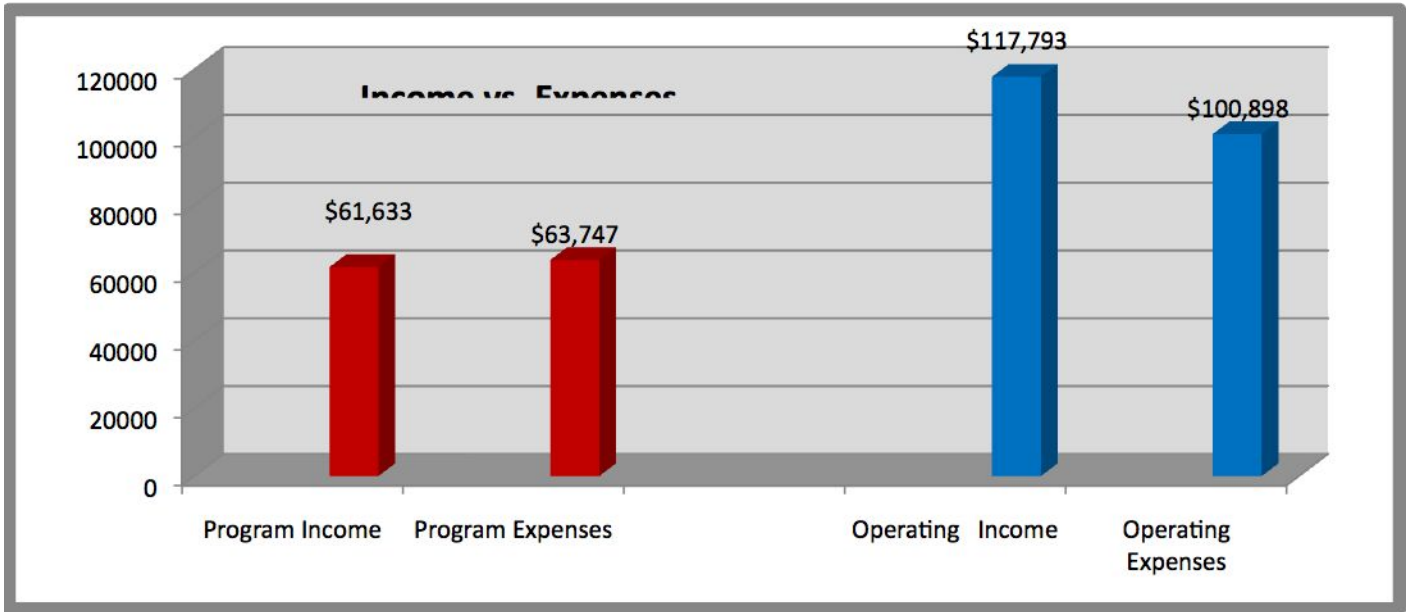
Incredible Summer Staff
